the capital city of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea. As one of the country's vegetable its groundbreaking in February giants, it boasts the world's advanced level of intelligent and

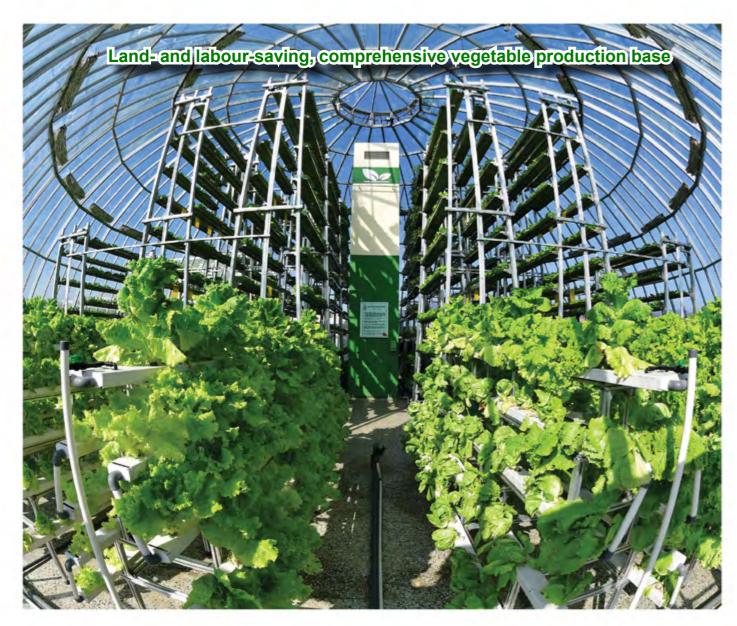

nutritional state of the vegetable crops, occurrences of diseases and harmful insects and others in each block, as well as the outdoor meteorological data, information on environment, soil and water quality of greenhouses, optimized production conditions for every growth stage are provided. Accordingly, concentrations of compositions of nutritive liquids and the amount and time of their supply, and the amount of carbon dioxide supply are automatically controlled, and stationary thermal covers operated.

Thanks to the establishment of closed-type nutrition management system, the greenhouse complex is lowering the norms of consumption per unit of output, as compared to other large-scale greenhouses.

The nutritive liquids that are used and discharged at the hydroponic greenhouses are recycled gravitationally and treated through several processes before being reapplied to production by means of automatic supply system.

At present the greenhouse complex turns out vegetable crops three times as much as ordinary vegetable production units do, and dozens of strains of functional vegetables including spice vegetables are growing there.

"We will pay close attention to diversifying the species, massproducing functional vegetables and improving the quality of products," says Ryang Kwang II, general manager of the complex.

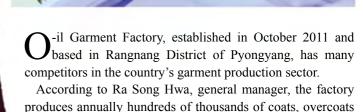

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Nationwide Efforts Go into Machine-building Industry

Interview with Jo Sun Gil, department director of the Ministry of Machine-building Industry

Reporter: Today the DPRK is directing nationwide efforts to developing the machine-building industry, an important sector in leading and driving the overall economy, and will you please explain about it in detail?

Jo Sun Gil: As you know, in order to develop the country's machine-building industry into an industry with solid foundations, an innovative industry, the Ninth Plenary Meeting of the Eighth Central Committee of the Workers' Party of Korea held in late December last year defined the renovating of major machine-building factories as the orientation of development for this industry, and clarified the ways for its implementation.

Accordingly, the machine-building industrial sector is giving priority to drawing up a long-term plan and making technical preparations to this end, in conformity with the developing trends of the world and in collaboration with relevant units. Along with it, it is conducting the work of strengthening its designing and research sector in terms of both quality and quantity, so as to put it on a high scientific and IT footing, design machines and equipment with competitive edge in international markets and thus turn itself into an innovative industry.

Reporter: It is important in developing the machine-building industry to stimulate the research of metallic materials and tool-manufacturing technology, isn't it?

Jo Sun Gil: Yes, of course. Fully aware of its importance, the machine-building industrial sector is readjusting the overall technical management systems of materials and heat-treatment processes, intensifying research into materials, introducing advanced steel-casting and other casting methods into the production of materials, and making the casting production specialized. And, in keeping with the fast speed of tools development worldwide, it is making efforts to intensify technical research into developing and introducing practical tools as well as to satisfy the demand for tools by expanding the production capacity and enhancing the sense of

responsibility of the units related with the supply of raw materials.

In addition, undertakings are going on in real earnest to perfect the production line of machine elements, a core basic sector in the development of machine-building industry, based on the principle of specialization and develop and manufacture high-precision machine elements.

Reporter: I think it is also important to develop and manufacture modern machine tools in consolidating the bases of machine-building industry.

Jo Sun Gil: Machine tools are the basic means of production for making other types of machinery and equipment.

As is well known, our country developed and manufactured high-performance machine tools to satisfy domestic demands as well as export them to foreign countries.

While designing and manufacturing CNC machine tools with high machining accuracy in line with the machine-building development trend and achieving domestic production of parts and devices necessary for machine tools production, we have gained rich experience. This constitutes a guarantee for developing and manufacturing more sophisticated machine tools.

At present, machine tools factories are pushing ahead with the work of equipping themselves with ultraprecision machine tools, modernizing their production lines, and developing and building various large- and medium-sized multispindle CNC machine tools of high productivity and precision.

And the project of turning the Ryongsong Machine Complex, a backbone of our country's machine-building industry, into a model of renovation is in full swing as part of the efforts to achieve a leap forward in the machine-building industry at the earliest date.

Reporter: Would you please tell me about the progress in the Ryongsong Machine Complex?

Jo Sun Gil: Well, equipping the complex with more efficient CNC machine tools, establishing up-to-date flow-lined processes, and manufacturing new machines and equipment, which are of crucial importance in improving the quality of products, are under way simultaneously.

It is also making efforts to build up the design forces with competent technical personnel and, based on them, develop world-class machines.

When these projects are finished in the main, the complex will take on the appearance as befits a modern, large-scale machine-building base.

And based on the experience gained in its renovation, undertakings to renovate the Taean Heavy Machine Complex, Ragwon Machine Complex and other major machine-building factories in the country are planned to be pushed ahead by stage.

Not only the major machine-building factories but also other similar factories in different parts of the country are making brisk efforts to update their equipment and production lines and improve products' quality and to manufacture in larger numbers vehicles, construction machines, mining machines, electric machines, farm machines and other high-performance machines for the various sectors of national economy.

Thanks to the endeavour of the government of the DPRK, the machine-building industry will be raised to a higher level.

Korea Foreign Investment and Economic Cooperation Committee

The Korea Foreign Investment and Economic Cooperation Committee, founded in December 2009, is a non-governmental body that specializes in the work with the domestic organs, enterprises and trading companies, as well as with the non-governmental organizations, associations of businessmen and investors and individual entrepreneurs of different countries that aspire after investing in the DPRK.

The Committee invites foreign non-governmental organizations, associations of businessmen and investors and individual entrepreneurs, and explains to them the policies, environment and laws of the DPRK with regard to investment and the projects for possible economic cooperation.

It arranges field surveys of the enterprises and trading companies in the capital city and other regions of the country as requested by foreign investors and helps them compile investment-related documents including contracts with selected partners.

It renders help in providing legal protection to foreign-invested enterprises in the country and creating an environment favourable for their business activities, and recommends to the government policy-related issues for the encouragement of investment.

Its activities also include establishing relationship between foreign investors and the DPRK's legal and financial organs, fiscal offices and other organs related with investment and helping the former receive necessary services.

In addition, the Committee coordinates the disputes between partners, which arise in business activities of foreign-invested enterprises and the DPRK-invested enterprises set up abroad and provides them with relevant legal advice, and offers cooperation on concluding contracts for major projects in the DPRK.

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Law of Democratic People's Republic of Korea on Foreign Investment

Adopted by Decision No. 17 of the Standing Committee of the Supreme People's Assembly on October 5, Juche 81 (1992), Amended by Decree No. 484 of the Presidium of the Supreme People's Assembly on February 26, Juche 88 (1999), Amended by Decree No. 780 of the Presidium of the Supreme People's Assembly on November 30, Juche 93 (2004), Amended by Decree No. 2367 of the Presidium of the Supreme People's Assembly on September 26, Juche 96 (2007), Amended by Decree No. 2688 of the Presidium of the Supreme People's Assembly on April 29, Juche 97 (2008), Amended by Decree No. 2842 of the Presidium of the Supreme People's Assembly on August 19, Juche 97 (2008), Amended by Decree No. 1991 of the Presidium of the Supreme People's Assembly on November 29, Juche 100 (2011), Amended by Decree No.878 of the Standing Committee of the Supreme People's Assembly on March 1, Juche 111 (2022)

Article 1 (Objective and status of this Law)

This Law is enacted for the purpose of encouraging foreign investment in the DPRK and protecting the legitimate rights and interests of the investors.

This Law is the basic law on foreign investment.

Article 2 (Definition of terms)

- 1. Foreign investment means an investment in the DPRK by a foreign investor of property, property rights or technical know-how for the purpose of carrying out economic activities.
- 2. Foreign investor means a corporate body or an individual of a foreign country that makes an investment in the territory of the DPRK.
- 3. Foreign-invested businesses mean foreign-invested enterprises and foreign enterprises.
- 4. Foreign-invested enterprises mean equity joint venture enterprises, contractual joint venture enterprises and wholly foreign-owned enterprises that are set up in the territory of the DPRK.
- 5. A contractual joint venture is a form of business activity, whereby investors from the DPRK and a foreign country jointly invest, the management is undertaken by the partner from the host country and the share of the investment made by the foreign investor is redeemed or the profits are distributed, according to the terms of the contract.
- 6. An equity joint venture is a form of business activity, whereby investors from the DPRK and a foreign country jointly invest and operate the business and the profits are distributed to the investors proportionate to the shares of their investment.
- 7. A wholly foreign-owned enterprise is a form of business, to which a foreign investor invests and which the investor manages on his own account.
- 8. A foreign enterprise is an enterprise of a foreign country that is registered with the investment management authority for conducting business

- activities or invests, without establishing a foreigninvested enterprise, according to contracts with institutions, enterprises and organizations of the DPRK.
- 9. A foreign-invested bank is a joint venture bank, wholly foreign-owned bank or branch of a foreign bank that are set up in the territory of the DPRK.
- 10. A special economic zone means an area where preferential treatment is accorded to business activities such as investment, production, trade and service pursuant to the laws and regulations enacted by the State for those purposes.

Article 3 (Establishment of foreign-invested enterprises and foreign-invested banks)

A foreign investor may establish and operate a foreigninvested enterprise or a foreign-invested bank in the territory of the DPRK. In this case approval shall be obtained from the investment management authority.

The investment management authority shall include the relevant central organ and the management authority of the special economic zone.

Article 4 (Protection of rights and interests of investors, provision of conditions)

The State shall protect the legal rights and interests of foreign investors and provide conditions for the operation of foreign-invested enterprises and foreign-invested banks.

Article 5 (Investors)

Foreign corporate bodies and individuals are free to make investment in the DPRK.

Overseas Koreans may also make investment in accordance with this Law.

Article 6 (Sectors and modes of investment)

Foreign investors may make investments of various forms in such sectors as industry, agriculture, construction, transport, communications, science and technology, tourism, circulation and financing.

Article 7 (Priority sectors)

The State particularly encourages investments that

are conducive to the introduction of high technologies and other state-of-the-art technologies, manufacturing of internationally competitive goods, construction of infrastructure facilities and scientific research and development of technology.

Article 8 (Preferential treatment for priority sectors)

A foreign-invested enterprise that invests in a priority sector for the establishment of business shall enjoy such preferential treatment as benefits in taxation, favourable conditions for land use and preferential bank loans.

Article 9 (Provision of preferential conditions for business in special economic zone)

The State shall ensure that foreign-invested businesses that are set up in the special economic zones are provided with preferential conditions for business activities in such areas as purchase, bringing in and taking out of materials, marketing of products, employment of labour, payment of taxes and land use.

Article 10 (Provision of conditions for entry and exit of foreign investors)

The State shall ensure that formalities for entry and exit of foreigners making investment in the DPRK are streamlined.

Article 11 (Prohibition and restriction of investment)
Investment shall be prohibited or restricted in the following cases:

- 1. Projects that are detrimental to national security, public health and healthy social and moral life;
- 2. Projects for the purpose of exporting natural resources;
- 3. Projects that do not fulfil the environmental protection criteria;
- 4. Projects that are technically outdated; and
- 5. Projects with low economic efficiency

Article 12 (Investment property and property rights)

A foreign investor may invest in the form of currency, property in kind or industrial property, and property rights. In this case, the value of the assets and property rights invested shall be determined by the agreement between the partners on the basis of the then international market prices.

Article 13 (Establishment of branches, representative offices or agencies)

Foreign-invested enterprises may open their branches, representative offices or agencies, and conduct joint operation with foreign companies.

Article 14 (Legal capacity)

Foreign-invested enterprises, joint venture banks and wholly foreign-owned banks shall be corporate bodies of the DPRK. However, branches, representative offices and agencies of foreign enterprises and subsidiaries of foreign banks established in the DPRK shall not be corporate

bodies of the DPRK.

Article 15 (Term of land lease)

The State shall lease land to foreign investors, foreign-invested enterprises and foreign-invested banks for their establishment. The term of lease shall be 50 years at maximum.

Land so leased may be assigned or mortgaged during the term of lease subject to the approval of the land lease institution

Article 16 (Employment)

A foreign-invested enterprise and a foreign-invested bank shall employ the workforce of the DPRK.

Some of the managerial personnel, and technicians and skilled workers for special jobs may be employed from abroad subject to the agreement of the investment management authority.

Article 17 (Tax payment)

Foreign investors, foreign-invested enterprises, foreign enterprises and foreign-invested banks shall pay income tax, turnover tax and property tax according to the prescribed procedures.

Article 18 (Reinvestment)

Foreign investors shall be permitted to reinvest the whole or part of their profits in the DPRK. In this case the whole or part of the income tax already paid on the reinvested share may be refunded.

Article 19 (Protection of invested property)

The State shall not nationalize or expropriate the properties of foreign investors and foreign-invested enterprises and banks.

Should expropriation is required for public interests, notification thereof shall be made in advance and sufficient compensation for its value shall be made through legal procedures.

Article 20 (Remittance)

Legitimate profits and other income earned by a foreign investor from business or banking operation, and any money that remains after the liquidation of a business or bank may be remitted out of the territory of the DPRK without any restrictions.

Article 21 (Confidentiality)

The State shall protect by law the business information of foreign-invested enterprises and banks, and shall not disclose them without the consent of the foreign investor concerned.

Article 22 (Settlement of disputes)

Any disagreement concerning foreign investment shall be settled through consultation.

In case of failure in consultation, it shall be settled through mediation, arbitration or legal procedures.



Unjong Cutting-edge Technology Development Zone

In relation to the brisk activities for investment attraction along with the establishment of the Unjong Cutting-edge Technology Development Zone, a reporter of the *Foreign Trade of the DPRK* had an interview with Chon Ho Gyong, head of the management office of the Unjong Cutting-edge Technology Development Zone.

Reporter: At present some special economic zones have been established and are in operation to make an effective use of the favourable natural and geographical conditions of the country. In this sense, the Unjong Cutting-edge Technology Development Zone is different from other economic development zones already set up in the country, I think.

Chon: That's right. The economic development zones that were made public on five occasions by 2015 in our country were established in areas with natural and geographical conditions and economic environment favourable for external economic cooperation.

The Sinuiju International Economic Zone and Amnokgang Economic Development Zone in North Phyongan Province, Manpho Economic Development Zone and Wiwon Industrial Development Zone in Jagang Province, Hyesan Economic Development Zone and Mubong International Tourism Special Zone in Ryanggang Province and Kyongwon Economic Development Zone in North Hamgyong Province border on neighbouring countries. They all have favourable conditions for entry and exit of personnel and transport of cargoes in transit and for developing tourism and foreign trade.

The Unjong Cutting-edge Technology Development Zone is to be set up in the Unjong Science Park with scientific research and education bases.

In other words, there will appear in this park an international hi-tech exchange centre to make the cutting-edge science and technology a driving force of expanding external economic cooperation and developing the economy and lead a pivotal role in establishing a hi-tech industry in the country.

Reporter: What about the environment for investment in the zone?

Chon: Unjong District in Pyongyang, the capital city and the political, economic and cultural hub of the country, has an excellent environment for investment. It neighbours Phyongsong of South Phyongan Province and has favourable conditions for gaining access to other countries through border crossings, ports, airports, highways and railways.

What is important is that, as there are the State Academy of Sciences, a large scientific research base of the country, and the University of Sciences, a training base of sci-tech talents, foundations for scientific research have been provided and the whole course of R&D, manufacture, service and living are integrated.

Enterprises that are to conduct business activities in the

zone can obtain high economic effectiveness by introducing into production in time the research achievements made by the scientific research institutes and universities and conducting technical renewal and production of new products.

Reporter: Which enterprises are encouraged to be set up in this zone?

Chon: The investors who are willing to invest in this zone can establish their enterprises in the form of contractual or equity joint venture with a business in the DPRK or a wholly foreign-owned enterprise.

Production and marketing of tangible hi-tech products, technical service for intangible intellectual property and transfer of technology—these are three goals for management activities in the zone.

In particular, preferential encouragement will be given to the establishment of enterprises in the sectors of infrastructure construction, cutting-edge science and technology and production of goods with international competitive edge.
